About Photosensitive Seizures

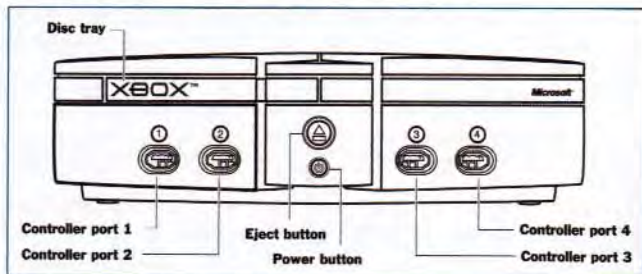

Using the Xbox™ Video Game System



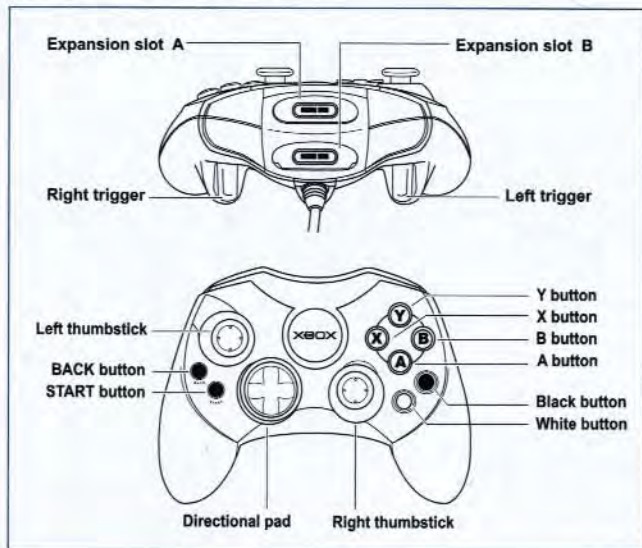
1. Set up your Xbox video game system by following the instructions in the Xbox Instruction Manual.
2. Press the power button and the status indicator light will light up.
3. Press the eject button and the disc tray will open.
4. Place the DOAXBV disc on the disc tray with the label facing up and close the disc tray.
5. Follow on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for more information about playing DOAXBV.

Avoiding Damage to Discs or the Disc Drive

To avoid damage to discs or the disc drive:

- Insert only Xbox-compatible discs into the disc drive.
- Never use oddly shaped discs, such as star-shaped or heart-shaped discs.
- Do not leave a disc in the Xbox console for extended periods when not in use.
- Do not move the Xbox console while the power is on and a disc is inserted.

This game is for 1 or 2 players. Here are some controller basics to help you get started.



*You will need another controller (sold separately) for a 2-player game.

*The Vibration setting can be changed under Options (p. 37).

• Game Basics

Controlling your volleyball player is simple, with only 2 buttons to worry about.

- Ⓐ buttonReturns ball to opponent's court
- Ⓑ buttonPasses ball to teammate

And that's all you need to know to have fun playing "DEAD OR ALIVE Xtreme Beach Volleyball."

• Games Modes

This game features two different gameplay modes.

1. Go to Zack Island (p. 20)
Make the most of your vacation on Zack Island by playing volleyball, doing some shopping, and even trying your luck at the casino.
2. Exhibition (p. 36)
Play beach volleyball with 1 or 2 players.



• Game screen

Score

Displays the score.



• Pause Menu

Press the Start button to pause game play.



Continue
Resumes game play.

Calibration
Adjust button sensitivity.

Give Up
Throw in the towel on your current match.

• Rules

- Matches use the rally point system, where the serve goes to whichever team has most recently scored.
- The team that gets 7 points first wins. Deuce may also be called. If the score is 9 to 9, the team that reaches 10 points first wins.
- There's no sideline or endline.

• Serving

Use Up and Down on the directional pad to change position before you serve the ball. To perform a serve, toss the ball with the **A** button and press **A** again to hit the ball on its way down.

Here you can determine what part of your opponent's court to aim for with the directional pad.



Overhand serve
A normal serve that's easy to time.



Underhand serve
Toss with the **A** button while pressing **←** on the directional pad (while facing right). It doesn't have much punch, but you can't miss with this serve.



Jump serve
Toss with the **A** button while pressing **→** on the directional pad (while facing right). It's tough to get the timing right, but it packs a big wallop.

• Receiving

B button



Lightly tap the **B** button to hit a serve or spike.

Hint

[Two Attack]

When you want your teammate to hit a Two Attack, press the **B** button firmly when you receive the ball. And when you want to hit a Two Attack, press the **B** button firmly as your teammate receives the ball.

• Tossing

B button



Time it right and press the **B** button as your teammate receives the ball. If you press the **B** button firmly, you can send a long toss to the net for your teammate to hit a spike.

Here, you can determine the direction of your toss by pressing Up and Down on the directional pad. If you lightly tap the **B** button when your teammate is in the backcourt, you can give her a quick toss for a back attack.

• Spiking



Time your spike right by determining the direction to spike the ball with the directional pad and pressing the **A** button at the right moment. When you want to force an opponent to block, tap the **A** button to perform a feint.

Hint

[Back Attack]

If you spike the ball from the backcourt, you will perform a back attack, with a wider range than a regular spike.

• Blocking



At the net, if you hit the **A** button at the right time, you can block your opponent's spike.

[Formations]

The computer will automatically control your partner, but you can also use the right thumbstick to give them directions.

Normal Shift **Press the right thumbstick (press down from above)**
Your teammate decides whether to block or receive based on your position.

Block Shift **Move the right thumbstick towards the net**
Your teammate will try for a block near the net.

Receive Shift **Move the right thumbstick away from the net**
Your teammate will try to receive the ball in the backcourt.

[Nice System]

When you get a nice play, your teammate will congratulate you, as long as you and your teammate are on good terms, that is.

In "Go to Zack Island" mode, you can gain bonus points through nice plays.

By a sheer stroke of good luck, the girls have managed to snag a vacation on Zack Island. There aren't any particular tasks to complete or goals to achieve here. Make the most of your time on Zack Island by playing volleyball, doing some shopping, and even trying your luck at the casino.



• Starting the game



To begin a new game, select the saved game marked NEW.

You need 3 or more free blocks to save vacation data.

After the opening movie, the character select screen will appear. Choose a character with the directional pad and the game will begin.



To continue a saved game, select the saved game you'd like to load and choose "Continue".

You can also select "Options" and adjust various game settings to your liking (p. 37).

Any saved game you load after clearing the game will inherit some of the features and conditions of the completed game.

• Map screen

Press left and right on the directional pad to choose the place you'd like to go. If you select a location where another character is and press **A**, the Chat menu will appear. Press left and right on the directional pad to choose the character you'd like to talk to, then press up and down to select the interaction.



• Chat menu

Play with them

Start a beach volleyball match with the opponent team.

You cannot play a match when you are not paired with a teammate.

Win and you'll get a nice cash prize!



Present

All of the girls have their own tastes, so be careful. Something that puts a smile on one girl's face may put you in hot water with another girl. You can only give items as presents that are wrapped. (Page 29)



Partner

Before you can play beach volleyball, you need to find a partner.

If the two of you don't get along, though, you may be turned down.



Hint

You can still ask someone to pair up with you even if you already have a partner.

• Gravure System

If you go somewhere alone, you can see Gravure movies. The movies change according to a number of conditions.



[Camera Control]

You can control the camera during swimsuit photo shoot movies.

By pressing (from above) right or left thumbstick, you can set the camera position.

• Inventory screen

Press X on the map screen, at poolside, or in most other locations to see what you're carrying. You can change your swimsuit or put on hats and sunglasses from this screen, too.

Hint

Check out swimsuit changes right at the poolside!



• Tanning

With the strong sun on Zack Island, when you are outside your character will get a tan. If you'd rather they didn't, use the Sunblock Lotion. On the other hand if you want them to tan faster, use the sun tan oil instead!

• Poolside

This is the hotel pool. The following is possible at poolside:



Leave the poolside

Return to the map screen.

Take a rest

Time will pass. You can watch a Gravure movie during this time.

Play Hopping game

Try this mini game that has you bouncing across the pool on the floating platforms scattered along its surface. You'll receive small prize money according to your clear time.

View items

View items in your possession.

Quit the game

Saves your progress and returns to the title screen.

[Playing the Hopping Game]

Press **A**, **B**, **X**, or **Y** to jump to the next floating platform.
If the platforms are close together, press the button lightly; if they're far apart, press a little harder to get across.



Hint

Change the button sensitivity with the L/R buttons on the directional pad. This setting also affects volleyball matches, so find a setting that's comfortable for you.



• Niki Beach



A beach on the eastern shore of Zack Island. It's named after Niki, Zack's girlfriend.



• Private Beach



Zack's private beach on the island's northern shore. There are some mysterious animals living there. Who knows where they came from?



• Jungle



A jungle in the island's interior. The lush vegetation means the sun isn't as strong here as on the beach.



• Bass Island



A small island off the southeast shore of Zack Island. It's so tiny, you can't even see it when the tide's in.



• Sports Shop

The Sports Shop sells all kinds of swimsuits. Stock changes daily, so you are sure to find a suit to your liking.



After you've made a selection with the **A** button, you can opt to have it gift-wrapped. Gift-wrapped items can be given to other characters as presents.



Hint

Once you unwrap an item, you cannot rewrap it.

• Accessory Shop

This shop near the yacht harbor stocks hats, sunglasses, sneakers, and other accessories.



[Remember]

Press the **X** button inside the shop or accessory shop to see whether you've bought that item before.



Rumor is that there are other shops on the island selling some pretty shady stuff...

• Radio Station

This is the radio station where Zack's a DJ.

Here you can choose what music you would like to listen to in the game.



Original "DEAD OR ALIVE Xtreme Beach Volleyball" tracks are already entered in the playlist. You can also select tracks that have been recorded onto the Xbox. Choose the songs you'd like in the playlist and press **A** to add them.

Please refer to your Xbox video game system manual for information about copying tracks from audio CDs.

Hint

You can have separate playlists for daytime and night-time.

Hint

While pressing the X button, you can switch tracks with Up and Down on the directional pad.

• Hotel

The hotel you will be staying at for your 2-week vacation.



Go to the Casino

Here you can play poker, blackjack, roulette, and try your hand at the slots (p. 34).

Make a gift

Send a present to another character's room.

Watch video

Watch videos in your possession.

View items

View items in your possession.

View Collection

Take out items that had been stored in the closet.

Go to bed

A way to pass the time until the next morning.

Leave tomorrow

Select this menu item to bring your vacation on Zack Island to a close and end the game.

(This menu becomes available once you clear the game)

Quit the game

Saves your progress and returns to the title screen.

Hint

[Putting items in the closet]

Choose an item at the Inventory screen and select "Store" to put it in the closet. Note that you can't store more than 2 of the same item.

Roulette

Take one card.

In this mode, the characters and court will be selected automatically for a round of beach volleyball. Up to 2 players can join the match.

*You will need another controller (sold separately) for a 2-player game.

• Character select

Select a character with the directional pad and confirm your choice with the **A** button. Select your character's swimsuit and, again, confirm with **A**.

If you're playing against a computer-controlled team, pick out their character and swimsuit as well.

Remember that you can't pair up two of the same characters.



Hint

[Level select]

Here you can set your skill level and that of the computer-controlled players. Choose from "Weak", "Normal", and "Strong".

• Court select

Select a volleyball court with the directional pad and confirm your choice with the **A** button.



Here's where you can change various game settings.



Controller Settings

Change button assignments, turn vibration on and off, and so on.

Audio Settings

Adjust the volume of game music, sound effects, and character voices.

Language Settings

Choose the language used for voiceovers and system messages.

Video Settings

Adjust the gamma, brightness, and contrast settings.
