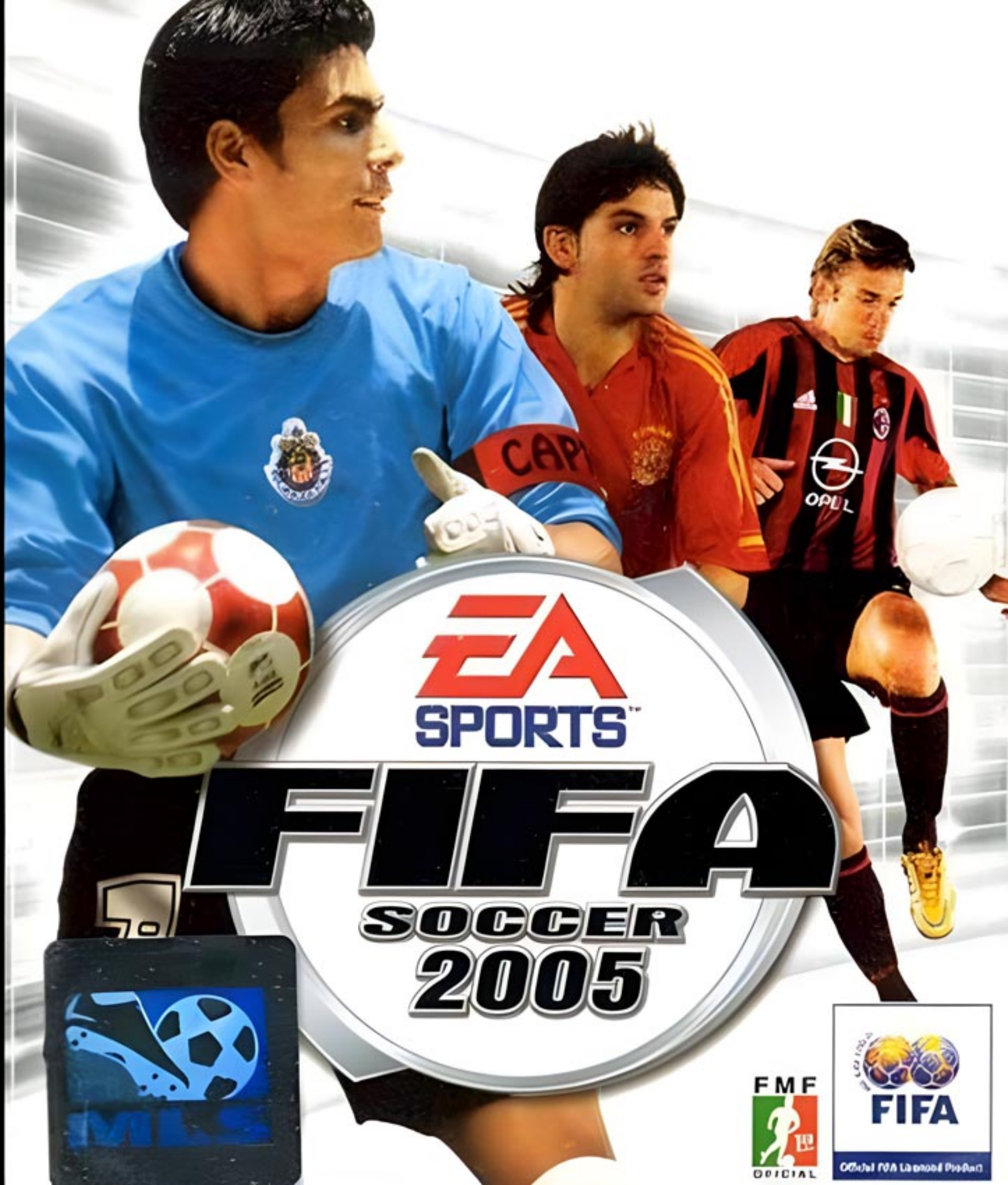

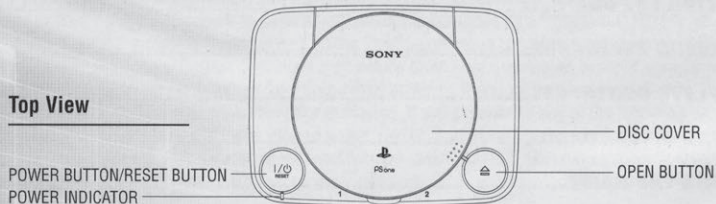

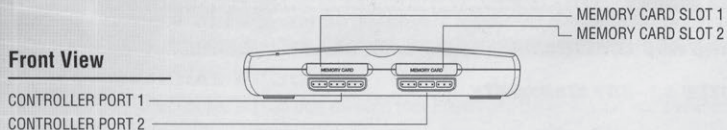

Top View

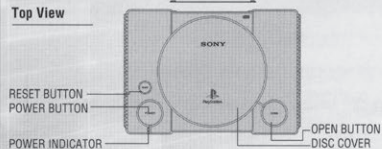


Front View

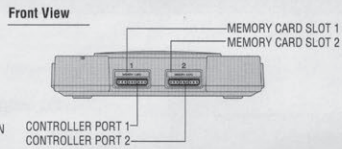

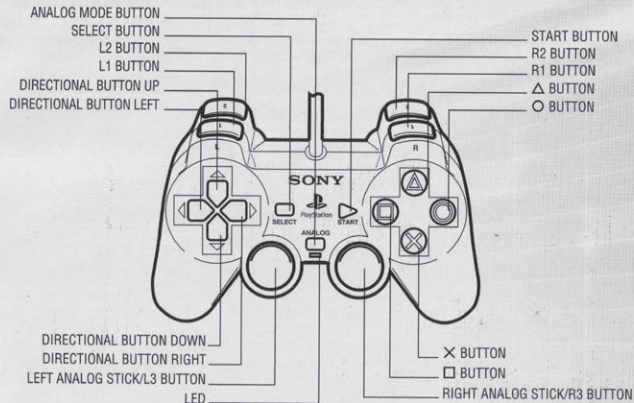
1. Set up your PlayStation® game console according to the instructions in its Instruction Manual. Make sure the power is OFF before inserting or removing a compact disc.
2. Insert the *FIFA Soccer 2005* disc and close the Disc Cover.
3. Insert game controllers and turn on the PlayStation game console.

NOTE: When using the Multitap, a controller must be connected to controller port 1-A.

4. After the introductory screen, press to advance to the Main menu.

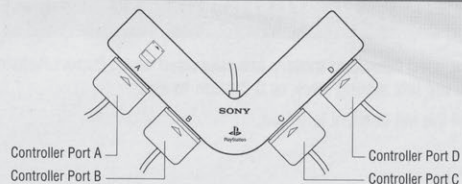

MULTITAP



COMPLETE CONTROLS

Whether you're playing a friendly match or competing for the championship, master these controls to dominate your opponents on the pitch.

ATTACKING (WITH BALL)

Move player	left analog stick
Shoot	○ button
Through pass	△ button
Pass	× button
Lob	□ button
Sprint	R1 button (hold)
Hurdle	L2 button
Sideways shimmy	R2 button
Aim throw-in	left analog stick
Throw	× button, ○ button, △ button, or □ button

POWER, WEIGHT, AND DIRECTION

When shooting, lobbing, or passing, a power meter appears at the bottom of the screen. Keep the appropriate button pressed to increase power (for speed and distance) and release when the meter has filled. If the meter reaches the red zone, your effort is more likely to be off target when shooting. Press the left analog stick to aim—the ball travels in that direction when you release the button.



NOTE: Passing, Lobbing, and Shooting meters are only used when Expert Passing and Expert Shooting are ON. Press the left analog stick or D-button to aim:

❖ Aim to the left/right of the net to shoot left/right.

PASSING

- Press the × button to pass. The ball is passed in the direction the ball carrier is facing.
- Press the △ button to play a through ball. The ball is passed towards a teammate—or the run of a teammate—in the direction the ball carrier is facing.

To play first-time balls (passing or shooting without first controlling the ball), press the appropriate buttons before the ball reaches your player.

DRIBBLING

The faster you travel, the trickier it is to trap an incoming pass or keep control of the ball. Try to balance your pace with the need for control.

DEFENSE (OPPONENT POSSESSION)

Move player	left analog stick
Switch player	× button
Conservative tackle	○ button
Hard tackle	□ button
Foul tackle	△ button
Setup outside trap (see p. 7)	R2 button
Apply defensive pressure (see p. 7)	L2 button
Goalkeeper charge	L1 button

COMPLETE CONTROLS (CONT.)

GOALKEEPING

Move/Aim, kick, or throw	left analog stick
Throw	□ button
Kick	× button or ○ button
Drop the ball	L1 button
Goalkeeper charge	Press and hold the L1 button (when opposition has possession of the ball)

SET PIECES

TAKING A FREE KICK, CORNER KICK, OR GOAL KICK

Set ballspin	left analog stick
Kick	× button, □ button, or △ button
Change direction of kick	L2 button (hold) + left analog stick

TAKING A PENALTY KICK

Aim shot	left analog stick
Switch kicking side	□ button
Switch player	× button
Shoot	○ button

NOTE: Hold the shoot button for increased power (only with Expert Passing ON).

NOTE: You cannot switch kick takers in penalty shootouts.

DEFENDING SET PIECES OTHER THAN PENALTY KICKS

Move player	left analog stick
Switch player	× button

DEFENDING A PENALTY KICK

Move along line/Choose diving direction	left analog stick
Attempt save	○ button, □ button, or × button

IN-GAME TACTICS (IGT)

TO ACTIVATE A DEFENSIVE TACTIC, USE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS:

Offside Trap Press the R2 button and your defense pushes up the field in an attempt to catch the attacking players offside.

Defensive Pressure Press the L2 button to apply extra pressure to an opposing player in possession of the ball.

NOTE: Any player affected by an IGT has a control highlight beneath him for the duration the tactic is active. IGTs can only be activated when the opposing team is in possession of the ball.

IN-GAME MANAGEMENT (IGM)

Press the SELECT button to change a team's formation and strategy during play to one of three settings you've created (IGM 1-IGM 3). Once you press a button to activate a formation and strategy, that setting remains until another is activated or a new game is started.

NOTE: Select TEAM MANAGEMENT from the Pause menu to customize your IGM during a match.

SETTING UP THE GAME

Adjust your settings and options before you hit the pitch.

SETTINGS

Press the L1/R1 buttons to select BASIC SETTINGS, ADVANCED SETTINGS, MORE SETTINGS, AUDIO SETTINGS, or CONTROL SETTINGS.

NOTE: Control Settings cannot be adjusted during a match.

NOTE: Settings can be saved to a MEMORY CARD in MEMORY CARD slot 1 by pressing the □ button.

NOTE: If saved Settings are detected on the MEMORY CARD in MEMORY CARD slot 1, they are automatically loaded upon power up.

FATIGUE

This level decreases the more a player sprints (the **R1** button), slowing him down, but replenishes when he returns to normal pace.

GAME MODES

FIFA Soccer 2005 offers you a variety of game modes to play how you want.

NOTE: Most of the game modes in *FIFA Soccer 2005* are self-explanatory and are not covered in this manual. Exceptions are listed below.

PLAY NOW

Get straight onto the pitch and take on any club or country in a game with your favorite team.

NOTE: Press the **○** button while selecting leagues/teams to access **Settings**.

MULTIPLAYER MATCHES

Up to eight players may play *FIFA Soccer 2005*, using a Multitap.

To play with 1–5 players, a Multitap is required and must be inserted into controller port 1 of the console. The controllers must then be connected sequentially to controller port 1-A, controller port 1-B, etc, with the fifth controller inserted into controller port 2. To play with 1–8 players, a second Multitap is required and must be inserted into controller port 2. If you are using a MEMORY CARD it must be inserted into MEMORY CARD slot 1-A of the Multitap.

SEASON

Attempt to win league and cup honors by picking a club team from one of 12 leagues and playing through three consecutive seasons.

SAVING AND LOADING

NOTE: *FIFA Soccer 2005* supports MEMORY CARD slot 1 and MEMORY CARD slot 2 for saving games. Settings can only be saved or loaded from MEMORY CARD slot 1.

NOTE: If you exit a game mode without saving, you lose all progress made during that session.

NOTE: You may save up to five games on your MEMORY CARD, or four games and the game settings.

NOTE: Never insert or remove a MEMORY CARD while loading or saving, or during the formatting process.

SAVING

➤ Select SAVE GAME in the More Options screen to save a *FIFA Soccer 2005* game.

NOTE: A saved game has its own database. Any changes made to teams from within a saved game stay specific to that game and do not alter original settings.

LOADING

➤ Select LOAD GAME in the Game Modes screen to load a saved *FIFA Soccer 2005* game.
